

Conditions and Clarifications Related to Attendance/Program Boundary Changes and School Closings for the 2012-13 School Year

Conditions

Reduce Enrollment at Viera High School (Proposal 1)

1. Grandfathering: Rising 10th graders, 11th graders and 12th graders may stay at their current school. An out-of-area application must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval. There is no sibling preference or transportation for grandfathered students.
2. School Board Policy 7120: Enforce the capacity restriction for new out-of-area approvals for all District Choice programs until 100% Capacity Utilization is achieved. Enforce the non-renewal provision for all existing out-of-area students not in a Choice program (students of school-based employees are exempt).

Reduce Enrollment at Cocoa Beach Jr/Sr High School (Proposal 2)

1. Grandfathering: Rising 8th graders, 10th graders, 11th graders and 12th graders may stay at their current school. An out-of-area application must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval.
2. Sibling Preference: There is no sibling preference for grandfathered students unless they are enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Program.
3. Transportation: There is no transportation for grandfathered students unless they are enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Program. Grandfathered students in the International Baccalaureate Program will receive Corridor Busing (if Corridor Busing exists District-wide).
4. School Board Policy 7120
 - a. Waive the capacity restriction for out-of-area approvals for the International Baccalaureate Program until 100% Capacity Utilization is achieved. This waiver applies only to students within the International Baccalaureate Program boundary – all International Baccalaureate students must reside within the International Baccalaureate Program boundaries.
 - b. Enforce the capacity restriction for new out-of-area approvals for all other District Choice programs until 100% Capacity Utilization is achieved.
 - c. Enforce the non-renewal provision for all existing out-of-area students not in a District Choice program (students of school-based employees are exempt).
5. Incoming 7th grade classes are limited to a maximum of 200 students.

6. Students that successfully complete the 8th grade International Baccalaureate Program at Clearlake Middle School are guaranteed admittance to the 9th grade International Baccalaureate Program at Cocoa Beach Jr/Sr High School.

7. February 14, 2012 School Board Meeting Decision: The 50 student set-aside for Freedom 7 students qualifying for the Middle Years International Baccalaureate Program at Cocoa Beach Jr/Sr High School is terminated, effective immediately.

Reduce Enrollment at Kennedy Middle School (Proposal 3)

1. Grandfathering: Rising 8th graders may stay at their current school. An out-of-area application must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval.
2. Sibling Preference: There is no sibling preference for grandfathered students unless they are enrolled in the Pre-Cambridge Program.
3. Transportation: There is no transportation for grandfathered students unless they are enrolled in the Pre-Cambridge Program. Grandfathered students in the Pre-Cambridge Program will receive Corridor Busing (if Corridor Busing exists District-wide).
4. School Board Policy 7120: Enforce the non-renewal provision for all existing out-of-area students not in the Pre-Cambridge Program (students of school-based employees are exempt).

Reduce Enrollment at Meadowlane Primary, Meadowlane Intermediate and Riviera Elementary Schools (Proposal 5)

1. Grandfathering: Rising 6th graders may stay at their current school. An out-of-area application must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval. There is no sibling preference or transportation for grandfathered students.

Special Consideration Approved at February 14, 2012 School Board Meeting: All students moved from McAuliffe ES to Meadowlane ES for the 2010-11 school year and now moved to Lockmar ES may stay at Meadowlane ES, with transportation. An out-of-area application must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval. There is no sibling preference for grandfathered students.

1. School Board Policy 7120: Enforce the non-renewal provision for all existing out-of-area students not in a District Choice program (students of school-based employees are exempt).

Balance Enrollment between Astronaut and Titusville High Schools and Jackson Madison and Madison Middle Schools (Proposal 8A)

1. Grandfathering: Rising 8th, 10th, 11th and 12th graders may stay at their current school. Out-of-area applications must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval. There is no sibling preference or transportation for grandfathered students.

2. School Board Policy 7120: Waive the non-renewal provision for existing out-of-area students per Policy 7120 at Titusville HS and Jackson MS.

Close Riverview Elementary School (Proposal 16A)

1. Grandfathering: Rising 6th graders may stay at their current school (not applicable at Riverview ES). An out-of-area application must be submitted to the Office of School Choice for approval. There is no sibling preference or transportation for grandfathered students.

Clarifications

Reduce Enrollment at Cocoa Beach Jr/Sr High School (Proposal 2)

1. Sibling preference for the International Baccalaureate Program will continue.
2. Grandfathered rising 8th graders not in the International Baccalaureate Program will go to Satellite High School for 9th grade.

All Proposals

1. Students in District Choice Programs (e.g., International Baccalaureate, Career & Technical Education, Pre-Cambridge) are not affected by attendance boundary changes.
